Introduction

There has been a growing interest in sustainable development plans and in the pursuit of achieving a balance between economic growth, environmental protection, and social justice, in a manner that meets the needs of present generations while taking into account the needs of future generations. This trend emerges within an international environment characterized by the proliferation of environmental threats, including pollution affecting air, water, and soil, the aggravation of desertification, and the spread of waste. Consequently, current policies emphasize the need to address existing problems and confront present challenges while ensuring sustainable development through measures aimed at transitioning toward a "green economy," implementing recycling plans, adopting sustainable policies in the agricultural sector, and promoting rational consumption and exploitation of resources. In this context, natural resources and energy resources are managed in parallel with growing environmental concerns.

This orientation coincides with efforts to encourage diplomatic initiatives led by pioneering states and specialized international organizations in this field, against the backdrop of increasing global competition over energy and various resources, often without sufficient focus on environmental risks and sustainability.

Within the same framework, official and unofficial local actors in Algeria are considered a fundamental pillar capable of contributing to the construction of a sustainable development model at the local level. They constitute a space that requires in-depth study in order to address the main determinants influencing them, whether at the level of the local environment or at the level of the state as a whole. This is aimed at developing a sustainable development approach based on the involvement of all actors and the provision of a suitable environment at all levels to effectively implement sustainable development.

Accordingly, the conference entitled "*Local Actors in Algeria and the Challenges of Sustainable Development in Light of International Experiences*" seeks to provide a platform for academics, researchers, policymakers, and experts to analyze the role of local actors within the context of global challenges related to sustainable development.

Conference Issue

Through this national conference, we seek to discuss a set of cognitive, methodological, and thematic questions centered around the following issue: **What are the challenges facing local actors in Algeria in achieving sustainable development in light of international experiences ?**

5. Papers written in a foreign language must use **Times New Roman** font, size **12**, with margins of **2 cm on all sides**, and **1.0 line spacing**.
6. Submitted papers will be subject to **peer review**, and the best contributions will be published in a conference proceedings book with an **international standard number (ISBN)**.
