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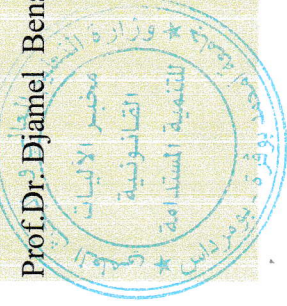

Introduction :

The most recent constitutional amendment of 2020 brought numerous developments in its content, the most notable of which was the establishment of a Constitutional Court to replace the Constitutional Council. This new body was formed differently, with broader powers that guarantee it a distinguished status as a constitutional institution.

The replacement of the Constitutional Council with the Constitutional Court reflects a clear trend aligning with the general approach adopted by the majority of countries worldwide.

The Constitutional Court is considered a fundamental guarantee for preserving the principle of the supremacy of the Constitution and for protecting rights and freedoms, furthermore, the Constitutional Court plays a significant role in ensuring the proper functioning and regulation of institutions and their activities. The public authorities and the resolution of disputes that may arise between the constitutional powers, in addition to its interpretive role of constitutional provisions, as well as its advisory role.

Accordingly, through the status held by the Constitutional Court as a constitutional institution, this forum seeks to highlight the expected role of the Constitutional Court through the powers granted to it in building and supporting the rule of law .
